


10. Rights and Privileges for the french Colony in Offenbach dated in 1710 (French)

Count John Philip of Isenburg-Offenbach (1655-1718), a Calvinist by confession, invited refugees to settle in his country for economic reasons in 1698. The French-Reformed congregation which was founded in 1699 was accorded privileges in 1710 by the court.
